IEF Ministers have welcomed the notion that cooperation between NOCs and IOCs holds significant potential to address key challenges facing the industry, to promote global energy dialogue and enhance global energy security. The IEF NOC-IOC Forum is recognised by industry leaders as an important platform for industry to discuss the dynamic business environment and its impact on stakeholder relationships.

Building on the findings and recommendations of the 1st and 2nd IEF NOC-IOC Fora, a report on guidelines and principles for successful NOC-IOC cooperation was prepared by the IEF Secretariat, in consultation with the IEF Industry Advisory Committee, and presented to Ministers and CEOs at the 13th IEF and 5th IEBF in Kuwait (March 2012).

At the 13th IEF, Ministers welcomed the NOC-IOC guidelines as an important framework for cooperation, called for the industry to continue the productive dialogue that is taking place in the IEF NOC-IOC Forum, and asked the Secretariat to update this document on regular basis.

The 3rd IEF NOC-IOC will gather experts and senior decision-makers from National and International Oil Companies and service companies to discuss current priorities and key challenges facing the industry, with a view of finding common grounds and strengthening cooperation and dialogue among the industry stakeholders.

Moreover, the discussions that will take place at this 3rd IEF NOC-IOC Forum will help the IEF in preparing recommendations for the 14th IEF Ministerial in Russia in 2014.
