



# 2010 Energy Mix






Total Energy = 39.17 MTOE Self-Sufficiency = 59.61%



#### **POWER GENERATION**




Gross Power Generation = GWh Total Generation = 65,795 GWh

### How Petrol is used




#### DUBAI vs. BRENT vs. WTI
