


There is a direct correlation between usage of solid fuels and deaths from indoor pollution



50 million LPG connections, Rs. 80 Billion initially allocated by Govt. of India


Enhanced Target of 80 Million and additional allocation of Rs. 48 Billion Scheme till March 2020 under the name Expanded Ujjwala

Beneficiaries received a 14.2kg / 5kg cylinder, a pressure regular, a Suraksha Hose in the scheme

Loan option for Hotplate and first LPG Refill available for beneficiary






- Poor households not covered under the above categories*














India Moving Fast to Clean Fuel
