
Achievements to date

- Capacity building material: JodiOil Manual
- 6 regional trainings since 2006
- Short term internships at IEF Headquarters
- Jodi becomes User-driven initiative
- Outreach to non participating countries/economies
- Communication platforms

Requirements for further improvement

- Addressing resources shortage in statistical divisions
- Building statistical capacity, experience sharing/transfer
- Setting an appropriate regulatory framework
- Addressing confidentiality issues
- Information beyond data
- Conduct more regular data checks
- Enhanced interaction with users



Progress on JodiGas

- Countries/economies participating JoilOil, 72 of which produce and/or consume natural gas
- Trial data collection on natural gas started in Dec 2009
- 42 countries/economies participate
- Gas Data Transparency Conference, Moscow, 26 Oct 2010
- Participating organisations continue their work with member countries
- Need for a capacity building programme like JodiOil
- Collaborate with the Gas Exporting Countries Forum (GECF) to involve more producing countries in Gas in JODI-Gas
- The ongoing work will be continued and will hopefully result in the first launch of JodiGas before the end of 2011



Progress on Jodi Investment

Addressing uncertainty on energy industry's future capacity to maintain supply and demand balance

- Resource intensive process
- Proposed questionnaire format
- Some organisations have its on-going work
- Collection of annual data on investment
- •Aiming at presenting a tangible progress by 13th IEF Ministerial in Kuwait in 2012
