48 countries updated the database with the most recent November 2023 data





Oil Overview: Update with Data Through Nov 2023

- Oil demand in JODI-reporting countries fell by ~1.6 mb/d in November and fell into the top of the 5-year seasonal range for the first time since April. Demand was above the 5year seasonal high from May to October.
 - The month-on-month decline was driven by China (-1.1 mb/d m/m), the US (-355 kb/d), and Saudi Arabia (-236 kb/d).
 - Aggregate demand was down 267 kb/d year-on-year.
 - China's crude imports declined by 1.2 mb/d m/m to 10.38 mb/d and were down 1.0 mb/d from year ago levels.
- Crude oil production rose slightly in November but was still marginally below the 5-year average. Crude production was down 0.9 mb/d y/y led by a 1.7 mb/d y/y drop in Saudi Arabia.
 - Saudi Arabia's crude production fell by 122 kb/d in November to 8.8 mb/d while its crude exports rose by 39 kb/d to 6.34 mb/d.
 - Canada's crude production rose by 263 kb/d m/m to a record high in November.
- Crude and refined product inventories built by 41 mb in November, but they remained 269 mb below the five-year average.

Gas Overview: Update with Data Through Nov 2023

- Natural gas production rose to an all-time high in November driven by gains in China, Nigeria, and Norway.
 - Gas production rose 0.7 bcm m/m and was up 7.6 bcm y/y. The y/y increase was driven by the US (+5.0 bcm), Nigeria (+3.0 bcm), and China (+1.1 bcm).
- Natural gas demand rose seasonally in November and was at the 5-year average level.
 - EU+UK natural gas demand rose seasonally but remained at the bottom of the 5-year seasonal range.
- Total gas inventories fell seasonally by 5.4 bcm month-on-month and were at a seasonal high.
 - EU+UK inventories fell by 4.3 bcm in November and stood nearly 95% full at the end of the month.






Gasoline Demand (39 Countries)

Diesel Demand (38 Countries) Million Barrels Per Day






Jet fuel demand fell marginally in November and was 3% below pre-COVID levels

Million Barrels Per Day







Crude production rose slightly in November, but was marginally below the 5-year average

Crude Oil Production (27 Countries)








Crude inventories rose by 24.8 mb in November while product inventories rose by 16.4 mb

Closing Stocks for Crude Oil (32 Countries) Million Barrels




Closing Stocks for Total Oil Products (36 Countries) Million Barrels


China's crude imports fell by 1.2 mb/d in November and demand fell by 1.1 mb/d



China: Total Product Exports Million Barrels Per Day China: Kerosene Exports Million Barrels Per Day







Gas production rose to an all-time high in November led by gains in China, Nigeria, and Norway


Natural Gas Production (33 Countries) Billion Cubic Metres





Natural gas demand rose seasonally in November and was at the 5-year average


Natural Gas Gross Inland Deliveries (44 Countries) Billion Cubic Metres

Natural Gas Closing Stocks (29 Countries) Billion Cubic Metres






EU+UK gas demand remained at the bottom of the 5year seasonal levels in November, helping inventories end the month at around 95% full
