Oil Overview: Update with Data Through January 2023

- Global crude oil production fell for a third consecutive month in January, by 365 kb/d to a seven-month low, driven by declines in Canada, Iraq, Russia, and Bahrain.
 - Russian crude production declined by 47 kb/d in January to stand at 9.98 mb/d a three-month low and 277 kb/d below year-ago levels.
 - Saudi crude exports rose by 221 kb/d to 7.66 mb/d a three-month high.
- Global oil demand declined seasonally in January and stood slightly above year-ago levels. Notably, this month's update did not include January data for China.
- Global inventories of crude and refined products climbed by 101.9 mb to an 11-month high. However, they remained 304 mb below the five-year average.

Gas Overview: Update with Data Through January 2023

- Global natural gas demand declined counter-seasonally in January by 7.7 bcm compared to a normal seasonal average increase of 15 bcm.
 - North America drove declines with US demand falling by 4.6 bcm and Canadian demand falling by 3.7 bcm.
 - Meanwhile, Japanese demand increased by 1.7 bcm.
- Global natural gas production increased by 0.2 bcm month-on-month.
 - Russian natural gas production increased by 0.8 bcm and stood at a 9-month high.
- EU+UK natural gas demand was ~25% below seasonal average levels. The region's inventories declined by 11 bcm in January, less than the seasonal average draw of 15 bcm. Inventories stood at 72 percent full at the end of the month.

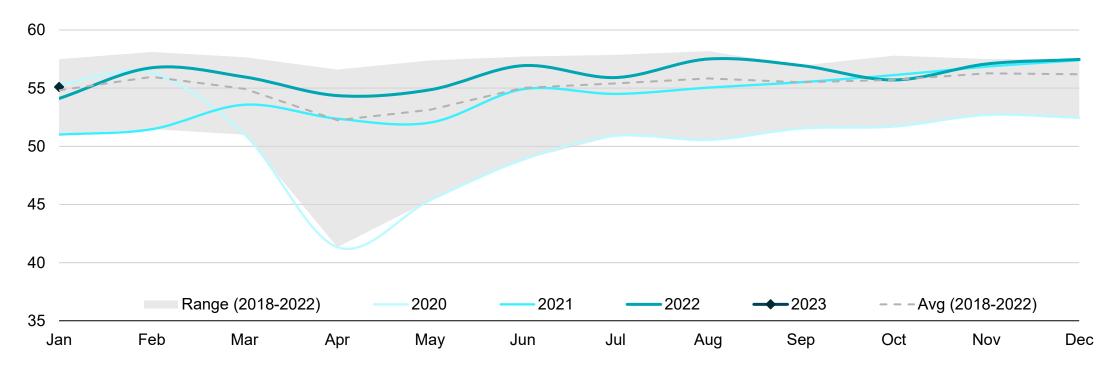


Oil demand declined seasonally in January and was in line with the 5-year average and 2020 levels

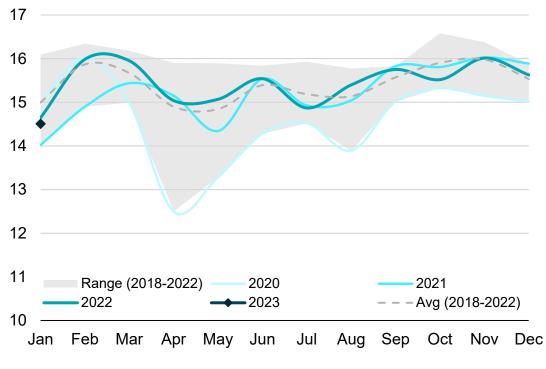
Gasoline and diesel demand were both below 2020 levels in January

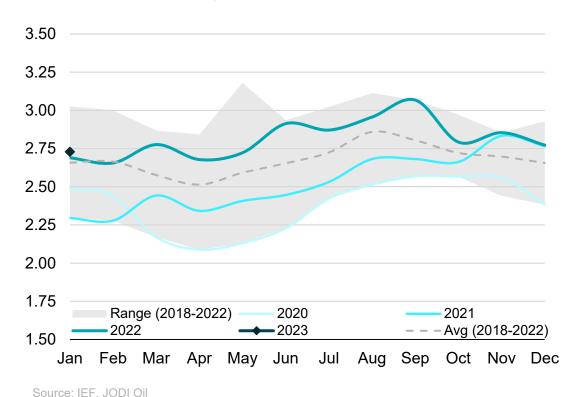

Fuel oil demand was slightly above year-ago levels while LPG demand sank to near the 5-year seasonal low

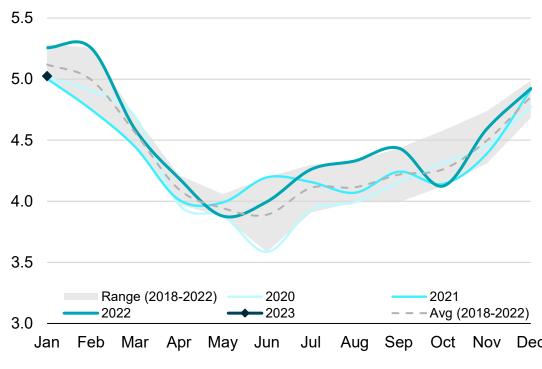


Million Barrels Per Day

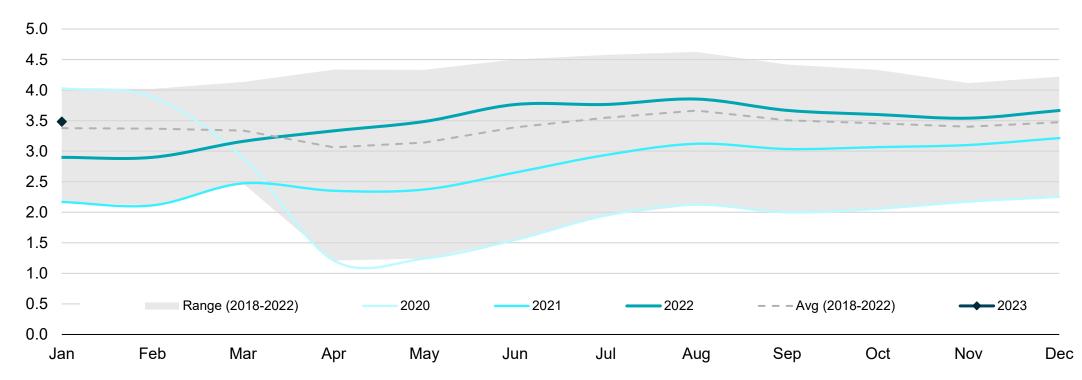

Million Barrels Per Day



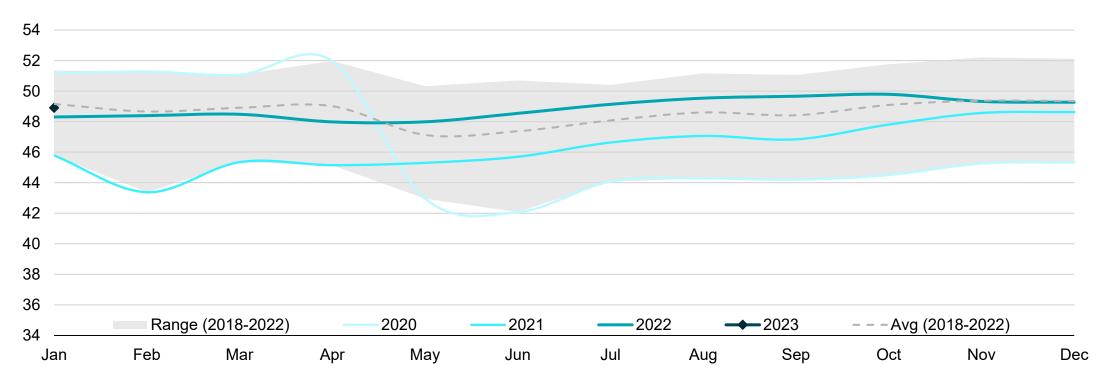

Crude Oil Production (28 Countries)

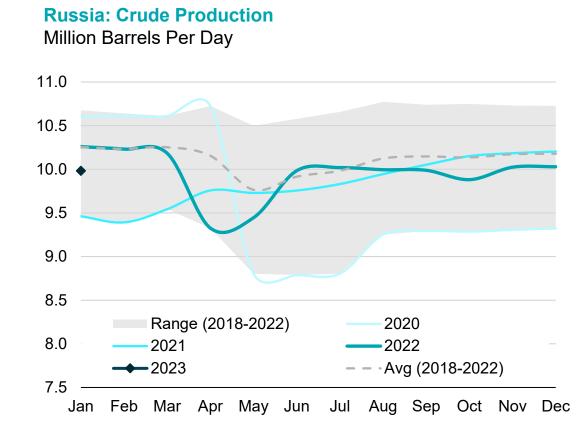

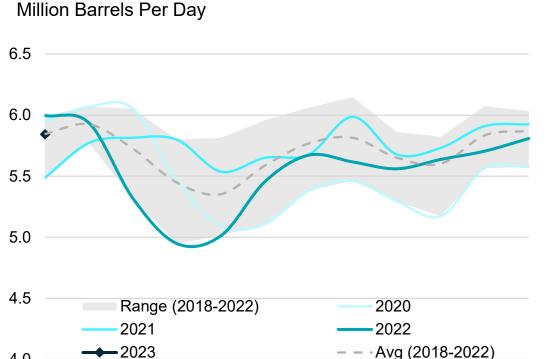

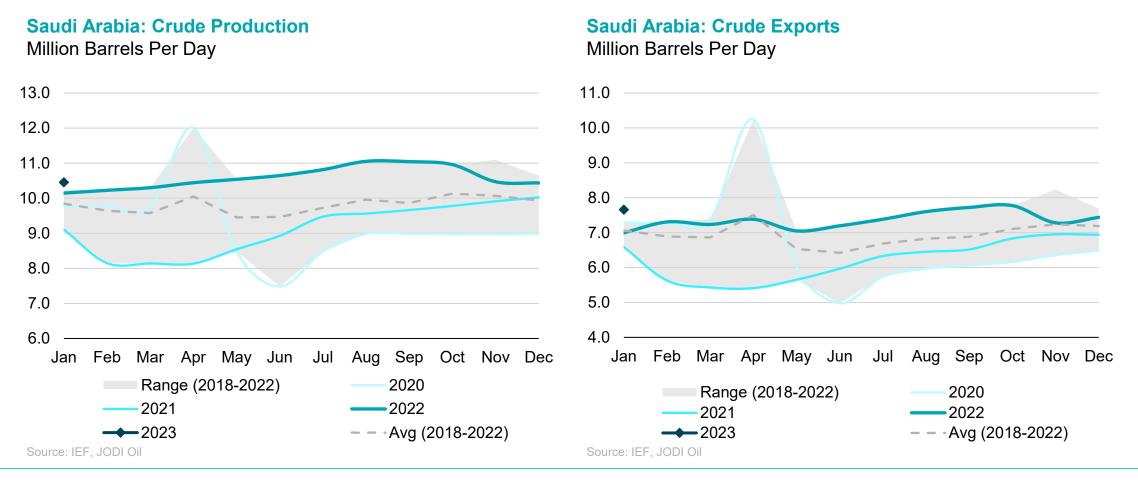

Russia: Refinery Crude Intake



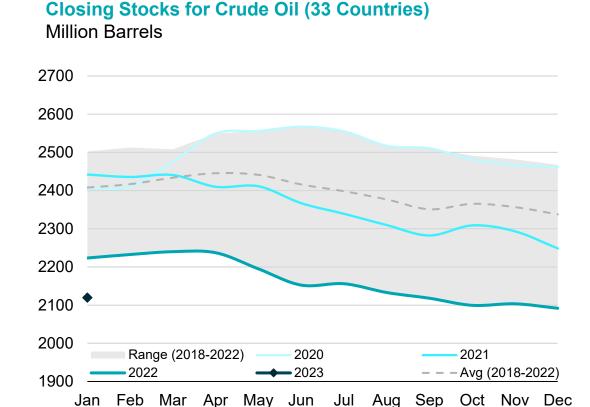

Saudi crude production and exports rose to 5-year seasonal highs

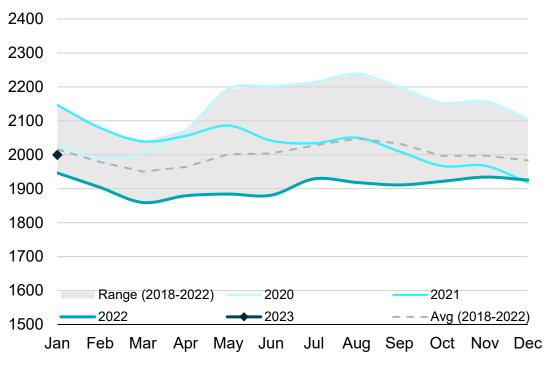




Crude and product stocks rose by a significant 101.9 mb in January but remain a combined 304 mb below the 5-year average

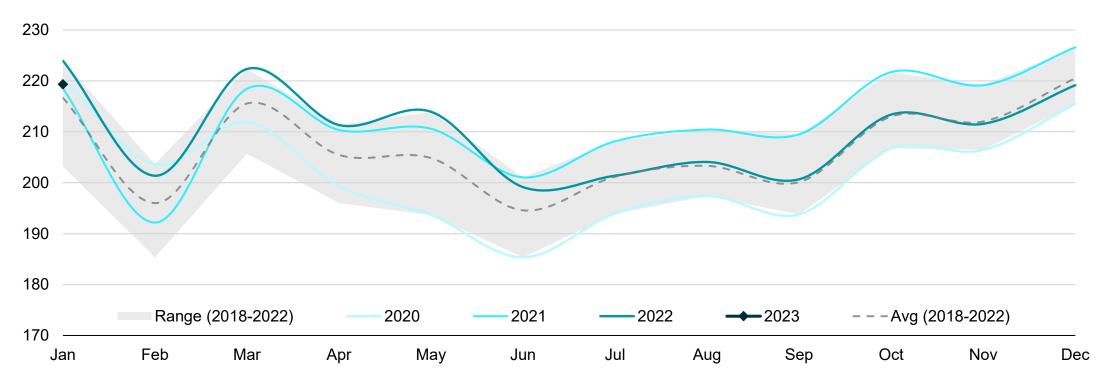

Billion Cubic Metres

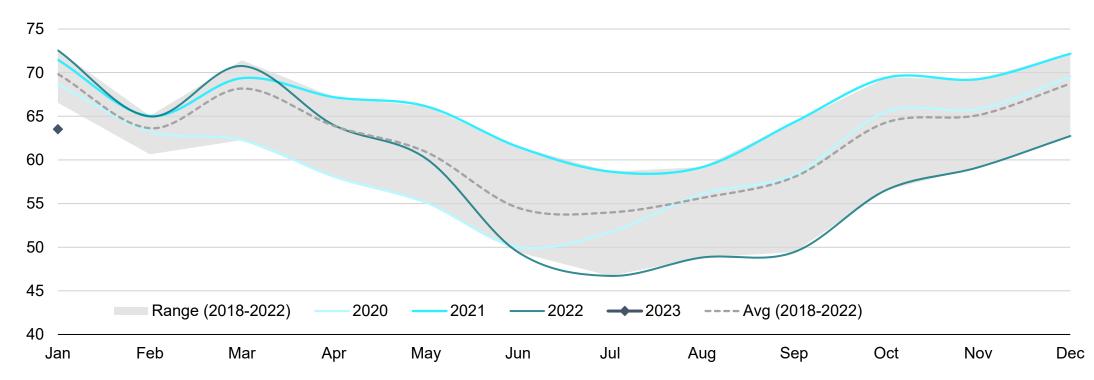




Russian production rose to a 9-month high but was still at a 5-year seasonal low

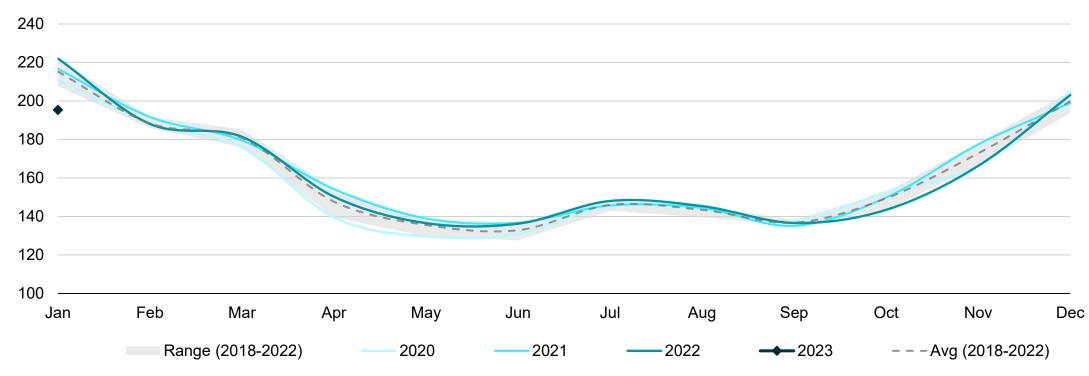




Global natural gas demand declined counterseasonally in January, falling to a 5-year seasonal low

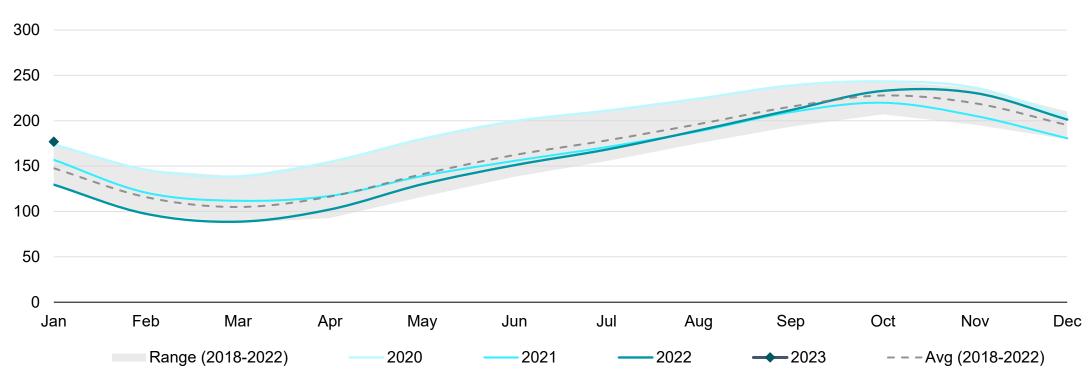




Total gas inventories were at a 5-year seasonal high in January

Natural Gas Closing Stocks (24 Countries)

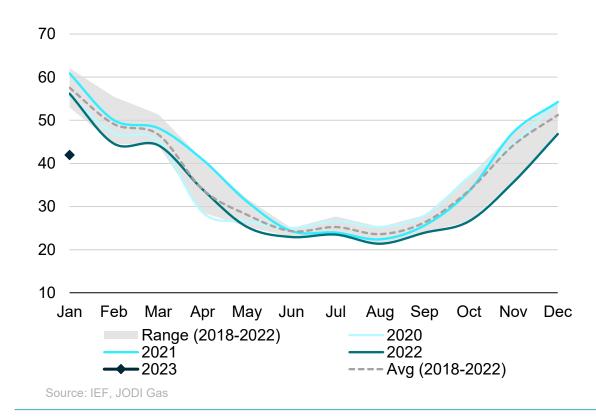

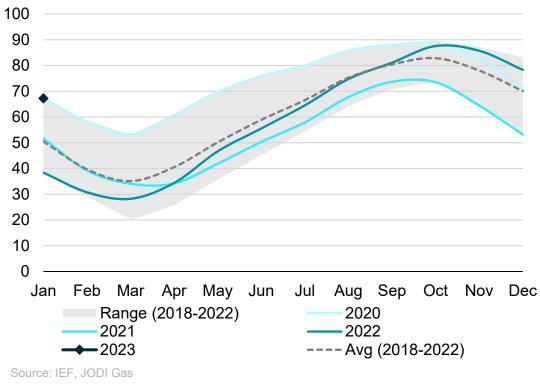
EU+UK gas demand was ~25% below seasonal average levels, keeping inventories at 72% full at the end of January
