Oil Overview: Update with Data Through Feb 2024

- Oil demand in JODI-reporting countries rose by 1.2 mb/d in February and was up 1.1 mb/d year-on-year.
 - The month-on-month gain was driven by gasoline and jet fuel demand. Gasoline demand was at a 5-year seasonal high.
 - Diesel demand and LPG demand both fell month-on-both. Diesel demand was below the 5year average for the first time since July 2022.
- Crude oil production rose by 473 kb/d in February as US production rebounded following weather-related shut-ins in January.
 - Crude production was down 1.2 mb/d y/y. Steep y/y declines in Saudi Arabia (-1.4 mb/d) and Iraq (-347 kb/d) were partially offset by gains in the US (+744 kb/d).
 - Saudi Arabia's crude production rose by 55 kb/d in February to 9.01 mb/d a 7-month high. Meanwhile, its crude exports rose by 20 kb/d to a 3-month high of 6.32 mb/d.
- Crude inventories built by 17.7 mb in February, but were still 262 mb below the 5-year average. Product inventories drew by 2.9 mb, but were 4.8 mb above the 5-year average.

Gas Overview: Update with Data Through Feb 2024

- Natural gas production fell seasonally in February, but was still up 7% year-on-year and was at a seasonal high.
 - The year-on-year gain was driven by the United States.
- Natural gas demand fell seasonally in February and was near the 5-year seasonal low.
 - EU+UK natural gas demand fell by nearly 12 bcm and was a 5-year seasonal low.
- Total gas inventories fell seasonally by 14.6 bcm month-on-month but they remained at a seasonal high.
 - EU+UK inventories fell by 6.2 bcm in February and stood nearly 63% full at the end of the month.






Crude production was down 1.2 mb/d y/y in February while NGL production was at a seasonal high





Saudi Arabia's crude production rose by 55 kb/d in Feb to a 7-month high while exports rose by 20 kb/d






Saudi Arabia's direct burn rose to a 5-year seasonal high while Iraq's remained near the top of the 5-year range


Saudi Arabia Crude Oil Direct Burn

Thousand Barrels Per Day




Iraq Crude Oil Direct Burn

Thousand Barrels Per Day






Oil demand rose by 1.2 mb/d in February and was at a 5-year seasonal high





Gasoline demand was at a seasonal high in February while diesel demand was down 0.9 mb/d y/y






Jet fuel demand was up 0.3 mb/d year-on-year in February




India's oil demand rose to an all-time high in February while its product exports rose to a seasonal high






China's oil demand fell by 967 kb/d in February while its product exports fell by 69 kb/d






China's refinery runs fell by 919 kb/d in February while its crude imports fell by 667 kb/d



Billion Cubic Metres



Natural gas demand was near the 5-year seasonal low in February


Natural Gas Gross Inland Deliveries (42 Countries)





Natural gas inventories fell by 14.6 bcm in February but remained at a 5-year seasonal high


Natural Gas Closing Inventories (28 Countries)






EU+UK gas demand was below the 5-year seasonal levels in February, helping inventories end the month at around 63% full
