#### Oil Overview: Update with Data Through April 2025

- Oil demand in JODI-reporting countries was up in April by 1.58 mb/d month-on-month (m/m) and by 1.68 mb/d year-on-year (y/y).
  - The m/m growth was driven mainly by higher demand in the US (+1.4 mb/d), followed by Italy (+293 kb/d), and Turkey(+100 kb/d).
  - The y/y increase was driven mainly by higher crude oil demand from the US (~ +1.4 mb/d), Nigeria (+268 kb/d), Italy (+255 kb/d), Canada (+245 kb/d) and Turkey (+84 kb/d).
  - The global Gasoline demand in the preliminary JODI reporting countries rose by 1.2 mb/d, and Jet Fuel by 346 kb/d, m/m. LPG demand in contrast declined by 287 kb/d, and Diesel by 82 kb/d m/m.
- Global Crude oil production in JODI-reporting countries rose by 201.8 kb/d m/m and by 1.16 mb/d y/y.
  - The m/m and y/y growth noted an increase of oil production mainly from Nigeria (+85 kb/d), Canada (+61 kb/d), and Saudi Arabia (+48 kb/d).
  - The y/y growth was mainly driven by higher production from Canada (+596 kb/d), Nigeria (+205 kb/d) and the US (+194 kb/d).
- Crude inventories in JODI-reporting countries were up by 28.3 mb in April m/m, settling at 173.6 mb below the 5-year average.
- Product inventories were up by 6.6 mb, m/m and settled at 52 mb below the 5-year average.

#### Gas Overview: Update with Data Through April 2025

- Natural gas production in JODI-reporting countries declined in April by 10.7 bcm m/m but rose by 8 bcm y/y.
  - The month-on-month decline was mainly driven by Russia (- 6.9 bcm), Malaysia (-1.3 bcm), Qatar (~ 1.2 bcm), Norway(~-1 bcm) and Azerbaijan (-0.35 bcm).
  - The year-on-year growth was driven by an increase of natural gas production from the US, Russia and Nigeria.
- Natural gas demand in JODI-reporting countries declined in April by 23.5 bcm m/m settling close to the last 5-year average.
  - The month-on-month decline was driven by lower natural gas demand from the US (-9 bcm), Germany (-2.4 bcm), Italy (-2 bcm), United Kingdom (-1.9 bcm), France (-1.4 bcm), Japan (~ -1.2 bcm), Turkey (~ 1), and Netherlands (-0.8 bcm).
  - EU+UK natural gas demand was down by 11.5 bcm m/m to settle at 28.2 bcm in April.
- Total gas inventories rose in April by 7 bcm m/m, and declined by 27.5 bcm y/y.
  - EU+UK inventories were up by 5.5 in April m/m to settle at 12.1 bcm lower than the 5-year average.

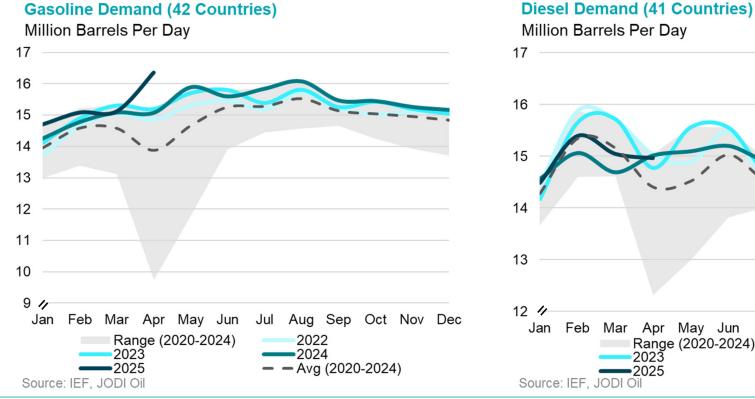


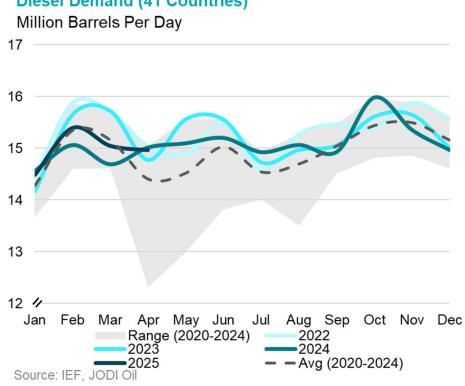

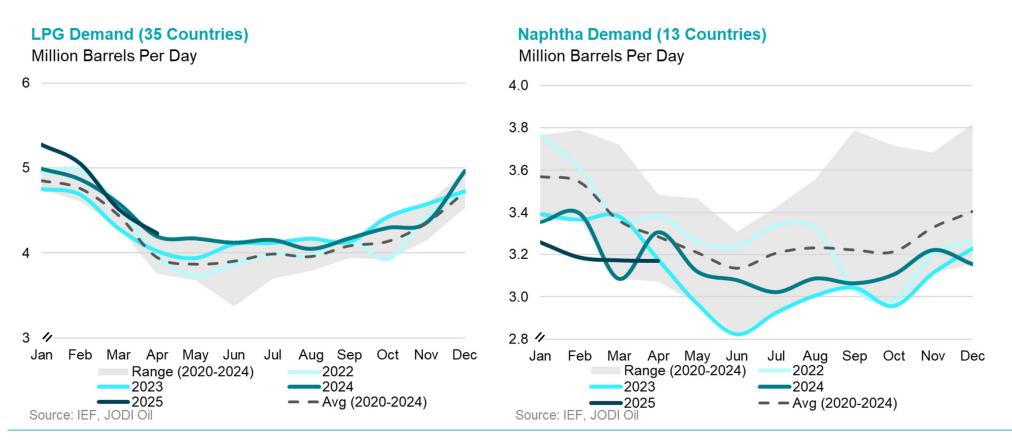
#### Gasoline demand was up by 1.2 mb/d in April while Diesel demand went down by 82 kb/d m/m





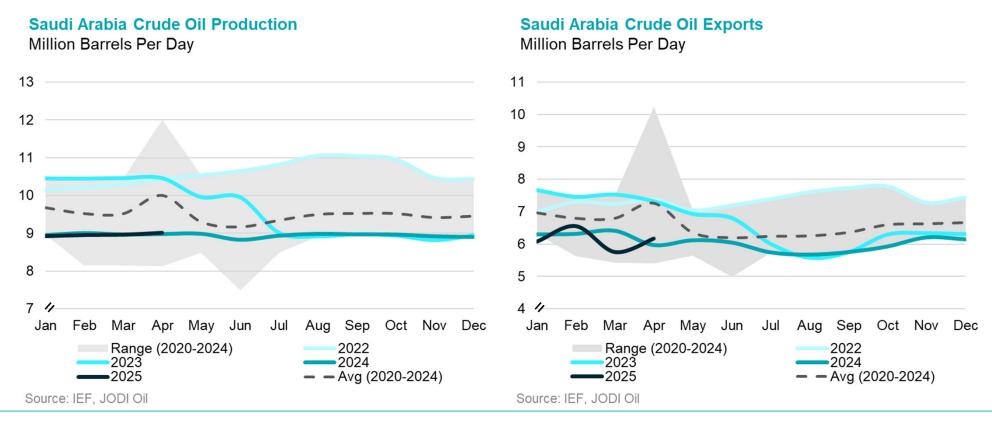


# LPG demand declined by 287 kb/d in April and Naphtha remained almost stable (-3 kb/d) m/m



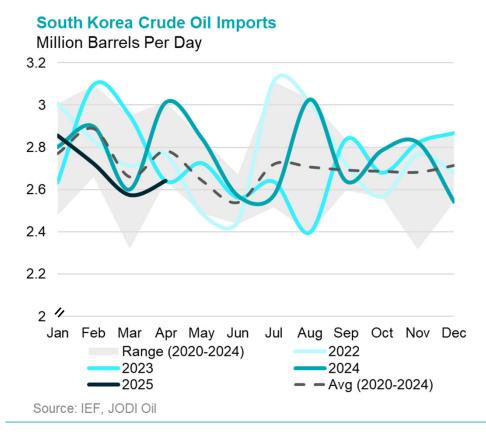


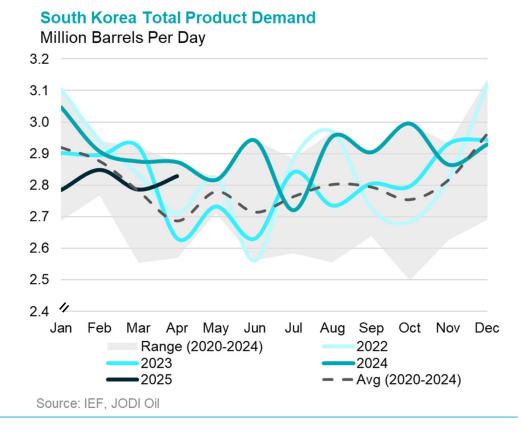
# Saudi Arabia Crude production rose by 48 kb/d in April and Exports by 412 kb/d





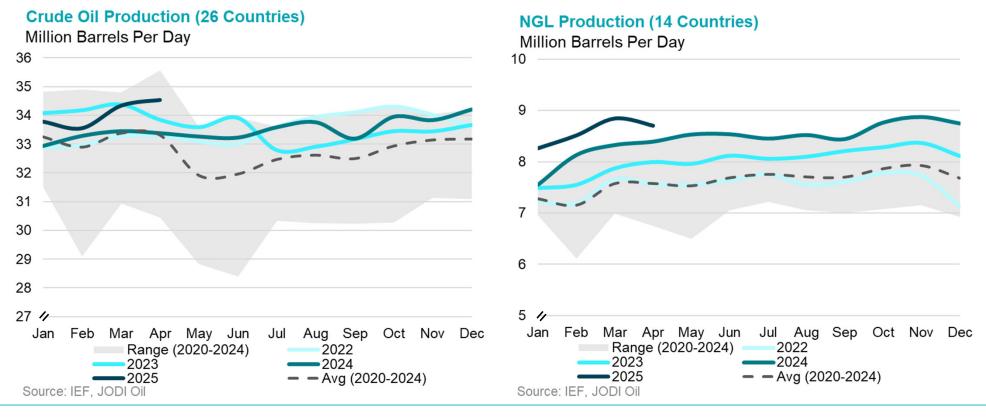
### South Korea crude imports rose in April by 67 kb/d and total product demand by 43 kb/d m/m





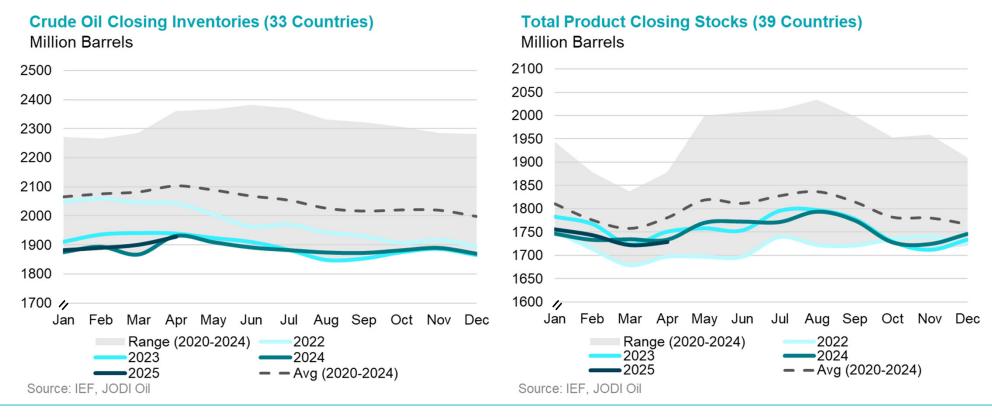


## Crude production rose by 202 kb/d in April and NGL production was down by 140 kb/d

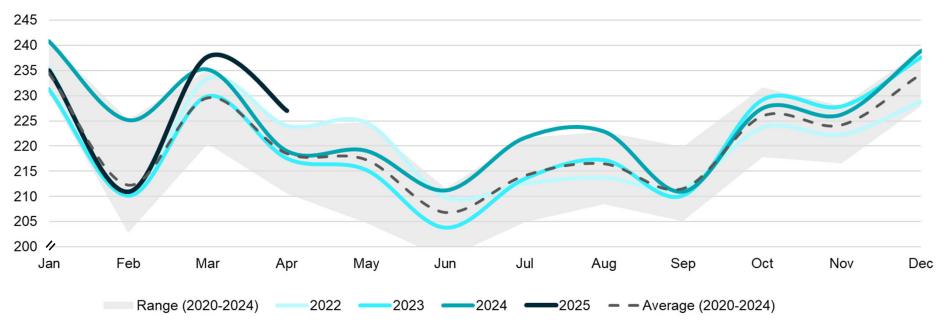

**Billion Cubic Metres** 

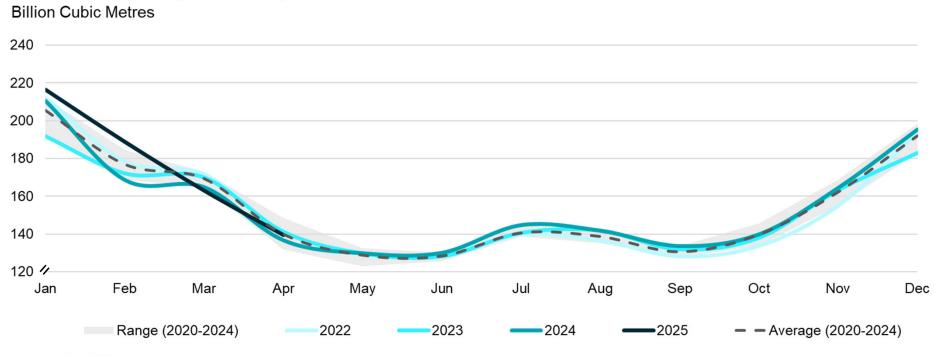

#### **Natural Gas Demand (46 Countries)**



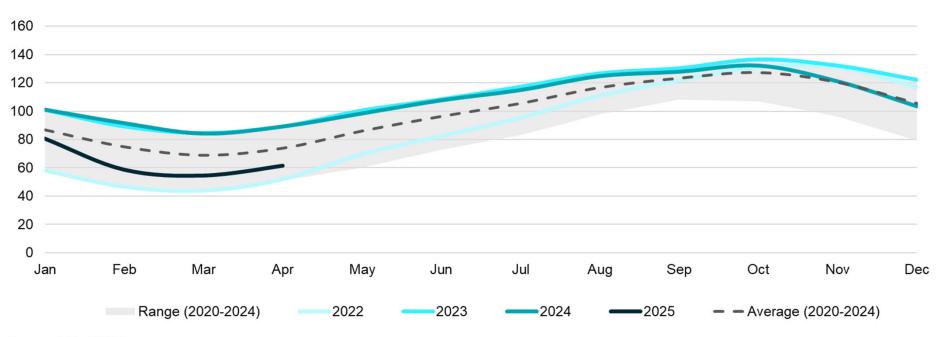




### Natural gas inventories rose by 7 bcm in April, and declined by 27.5 bcm y/y

#### **Natural Gas Closing Inventories (28 Countries)**

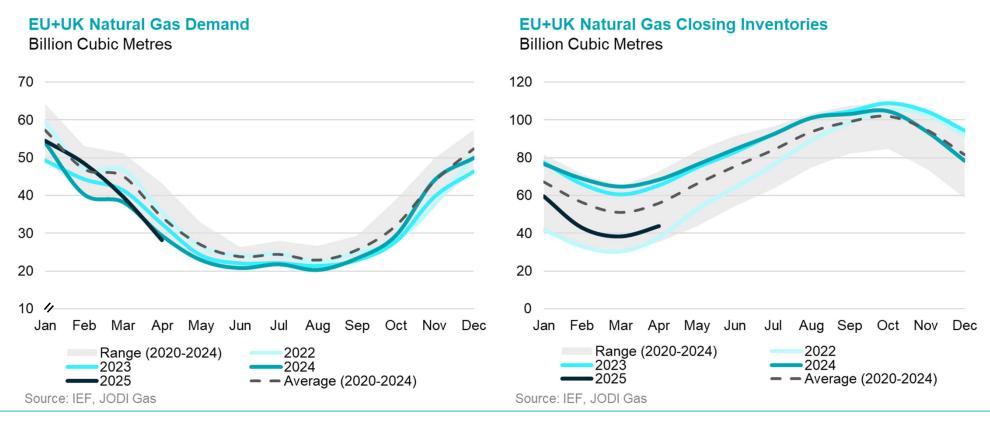
