Oil Overview: Update with Data Through May 2025

- Oil demand in JODI-reporting countries was down in May by 823.7 kb/d month-on-month (m/m) and by 493.5 kb/d year-on-year (y/y).
 - The m/m decline was driven mainly by lower demand in China (-558 kb/d), Japan (-286 kb/d), and Germany(-252 kb/d).
 - The y/y decrease was driven mainly by lower crude oil demand from the US (-411 kb/d), Germany (-184 kb/d), The Netherlands (-137 kb/d), South Korea (-133 kb/d) and China (-103 kb/d).
 - The global Gasoline demand in the preliminary JODI reporting countries rose slightly by 48 kb/d, whereas Diesel, Kerosene and LPG demand declined respectively by 960 kb/d, 147 kb/d, and 379 kb/d m/m.
- Global Crude oil production in JODI-reporting countries declined by 247.8 kb/d m/m and rose by 713.9 kb/d y/y.
 - The m/m and y/y decline noted a decrease of oil production mainly from Canada (-204 kb/d), the US (-70 kb/d), the UK (-66 kb/d) and Norway (-64 kb/d).
 - The y/y growth was mainly driven by higher production from the US (+197 kb/d), Nigeria (+192 kb/d), Venezuela (+156 kb/d), Norway (+101 kb/d) and China (+76 kb/d).
- Crude inventories in JODI-reporting countries were up by 7.8 mb in May m/m, settling at 169 mb below the 5-year average.
- Product inventories were up by 38.2 mb, m/m and settled at 56.7 mb below the 5-year average.

Gas Overview: Update with Data Through May 2025

- Natural gas production in JODI-reporting countries declined in May by 4.8 bcm m/m but rose by 0.7 bcm y/y.
 - The month-on-month decline was mainly driven by Russia (- 3.2 bcm), the US (~ -1.6 bcm), and Norway(-1.3 bcm).
 - The year-on-year growth was driven by an increase of natural gas production from China (+1.88 bcm), Qatar (+0.94 bcm), Nigeria (+0.86 bcm) and the US (+0.35 bcm). In contrast, y/y declines were driven by lower production from Norway (~ -1.1 bcm), Russia (-0.8 bcm) and Egypt (-0.7 bcm).
- Natural gas demand in JODI-reporting countries declined in May by 12 bcm m/m and by 2.7 bcm y/y.
 - The month-on-month decline was driven by lower natural gas demand from the US (~ -4.9 bcm), South Korea (-2.5 bcm), Japan (~ -1.5 bcm), Turkey (- 1.4 bcm), and the UK (~ -1.2 bcm).
 - EU+UK natural gas demand was down by 2.1 bcm m/m but rose by 2.8 y/y.
- Total gas inventories rose in May by 9.9 bcm m/m, and declined by 27.6 bcm y/y.
 - EU+UK inventories rose by 7.2 in May m/m but declined by 25.1 bcm y/y.







Oil demand declined by 823.7 kb/d m/m in May, and by 493.5 mb/d y/y






Gasoline demand went up by 48 kb/d in May while Diesel demand declined by 960 kb/d m/m








LPG demand declined by 378.8 kb/d in May and Naphtha demand was down by 61 kb/d m/m






Saudi Arabia Crude production rose by 179 kb/d in May and Exports by 25 kb/d







China crude imports declined in May by 721 kb/d and total product demand by 558 kb/d m/m






Crude production was down by 247.8 kb/d in May and NGL production by 523.3 kb/d



Billion Cubic Metres



Natural gas demand in May declined by 12 bcm and by 2.7 bcm y/y


Natural Gas Demand (47 Countries)





Natural gas inventories rose by 9.9 bcm in May, and declined by 27.6 bcm y/y


Natural Gas Closing Inventories (29 Countries)


