Oil Overview: Update with Data Through July 2023

- Oil demand in JODI-reporting countries fell by ~3 mb/d month-on-month in July but it remained at a 5-year seasonal high.
 - The m/m decline in demand was driven by China, India, and Indonesia.
 - Despite the m/m decline, demand was up 3.4 mb/d y/y. The y/y gains were driven by China, US, and India.
 - Gasoline demand was a 5-year seasonal high with Spain, Italy and Turkey seeing 8+ year high demand.
 - China's crude imports fell by 2.4 mb/d m/m to 10.3 mb/d a 6-month low.
- Crude oil production fell by 1.8 mb/d in July to a 22-month low, driven by lower production in Saudi Arabia, US, and China. Notably, Russian production data has not been reported since March.
 - Saudi crude production fell by 943 kb/d to 9.01 mb/d while its crude exports dropped by 792 kb/d to 6.01 mb/d a 25-month low.
- Crude and refined product inventories had a net build in July, but they remained 340 mb below the five-year average.

Gas Overview: Update with Data Through July 2023

- Natural gas production rose seasonally by 3.1 bcm.
 - Month-on-month gains were driven by Norway (+2.2 bcm) and Qatar (+0.7 bcm).
 - Russian gas production remained largely flat month-on-month at 7-year seasonal lows.
- Natural gas demand rose seasonally by 12.8 bcm in July and was near the top of the 5year range.
 - Demand gains were driven by US, Canada, Japan, Egypt, and Italy.
 - EU+UK natural gas demand rose by 0.3 bcm but remained below seasonal average levels.
- Total gas inventories increased seasonally by 11.7 bcm month-on-month and remained near the top of the 5-year range.
 - EU+UK inventories rose by 9.2 bcm in July and stood around 85% full at the end of the month.

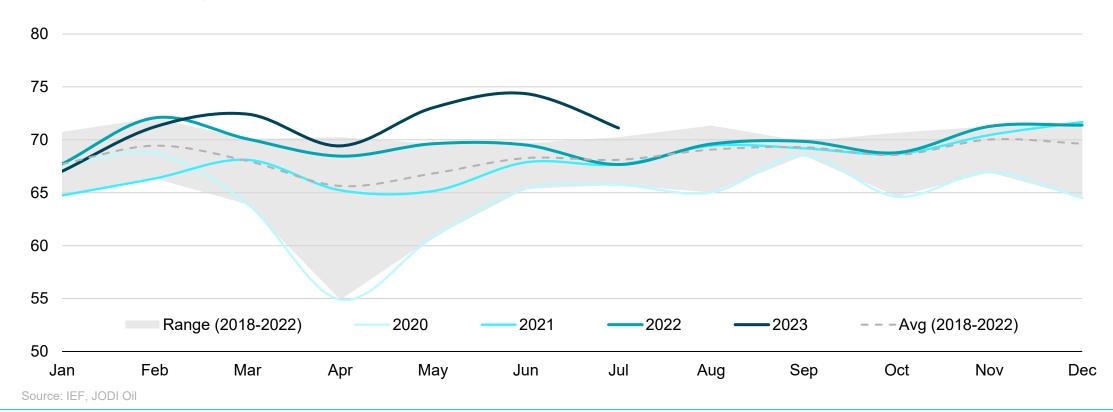


Oil demand declined in July, but it was still 3.4 mb/d above year ago levels & at a seasonal record high

Million Barrels Per Day

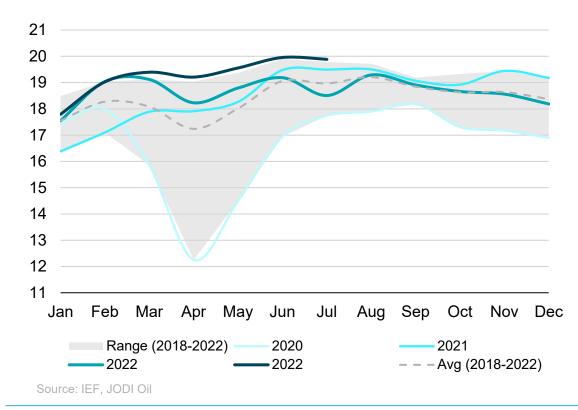




Gasoline demand was at a 5-year seasonal high in July while diesel demand dipped back into the 5-year range

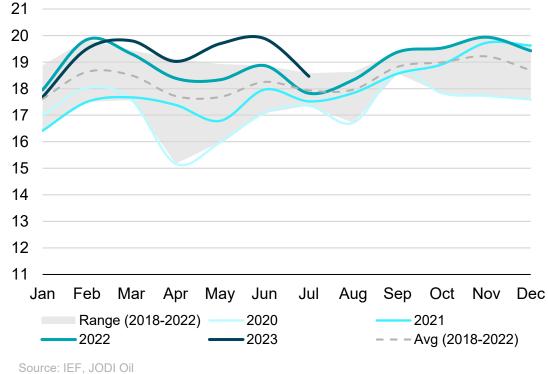
Gasoline Demand (41 Countries)

Million Barrels Per Day



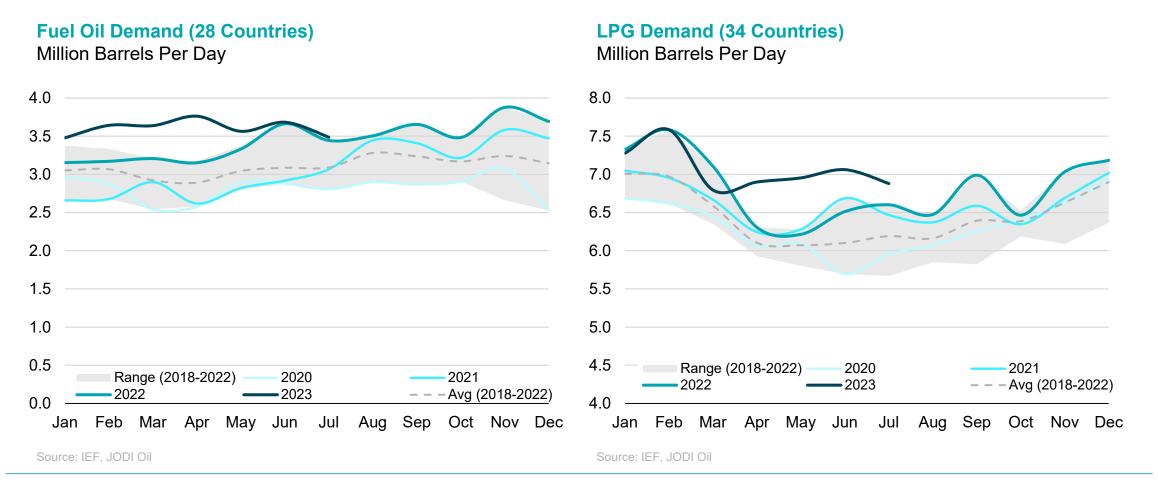
Diesel Demand (39 Countries)

Fuel oil and LPG demand were above the 5-year range in July

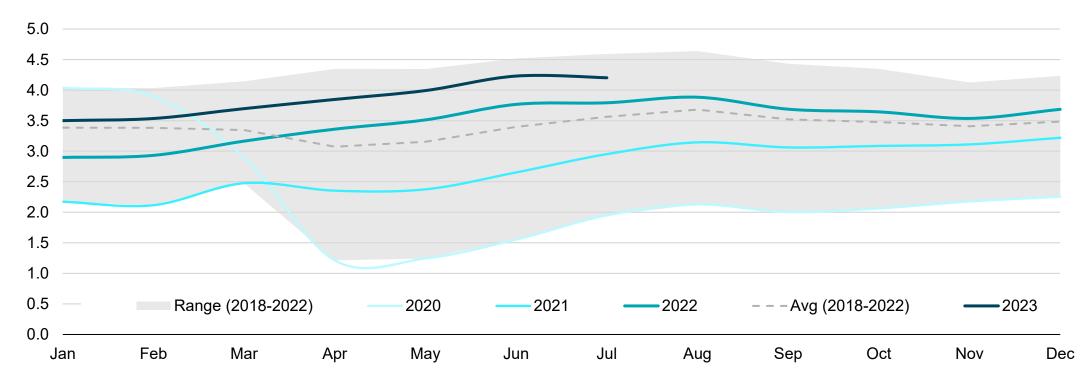




Jet fuel demand fell marginally in July and was still 8% below pre-COVID levels

Million Barrels Per Day



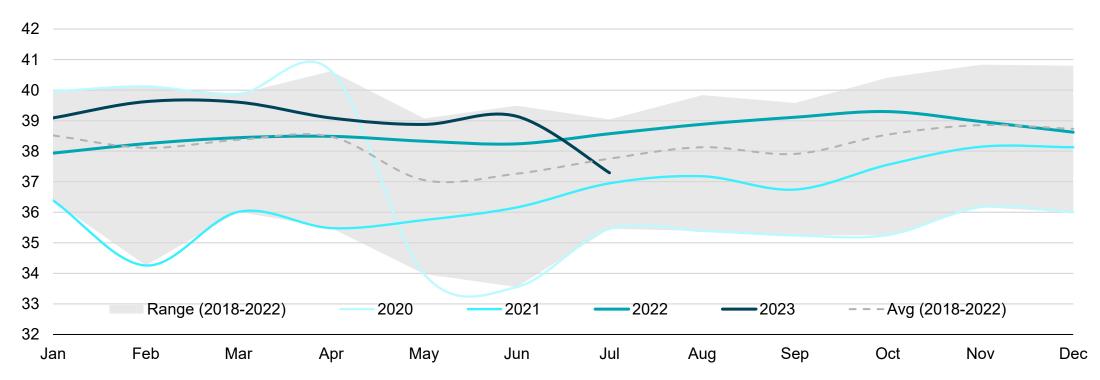

Million Barrels Per Day

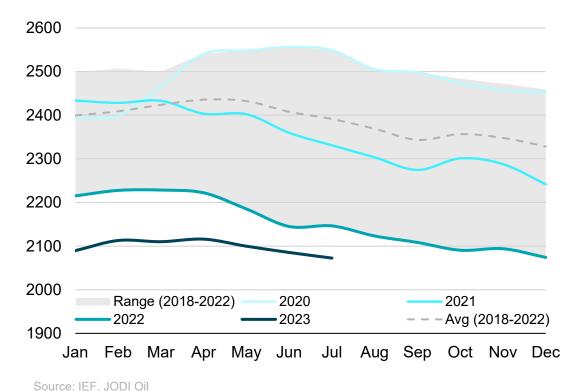

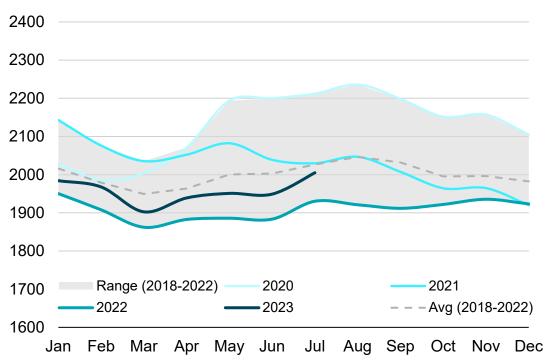


Crude inventories fell by 12.8 mb in July while product inventories rose by 56* mb

Million Barrels

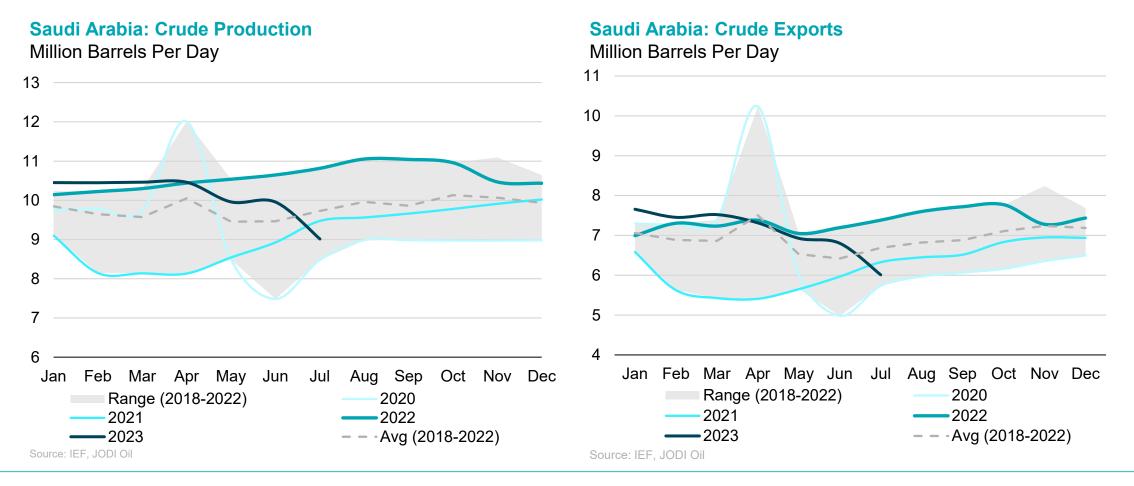

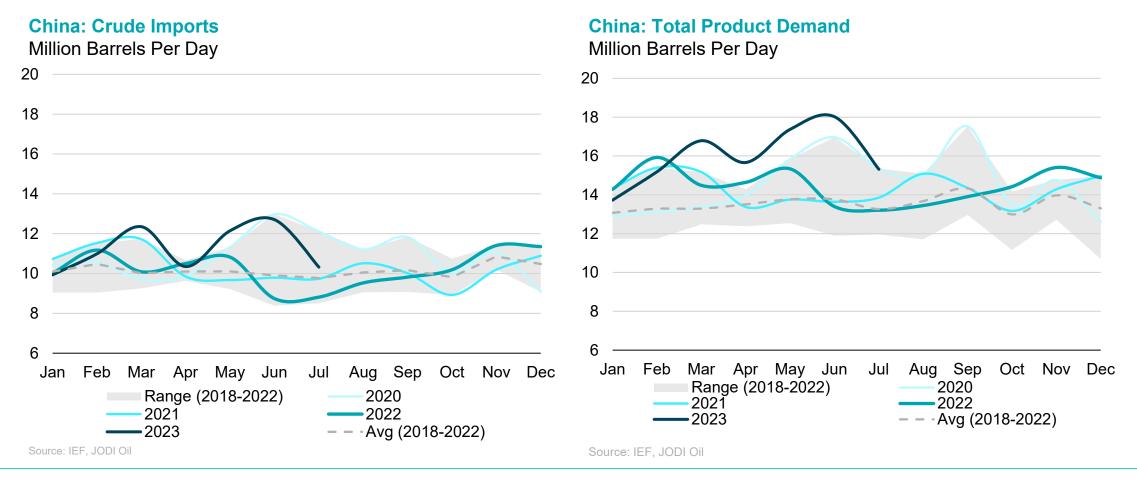


Saudi crude production fell by 943 kb/d in July while crude exports dropped by 792 kb/d to a 25-month low



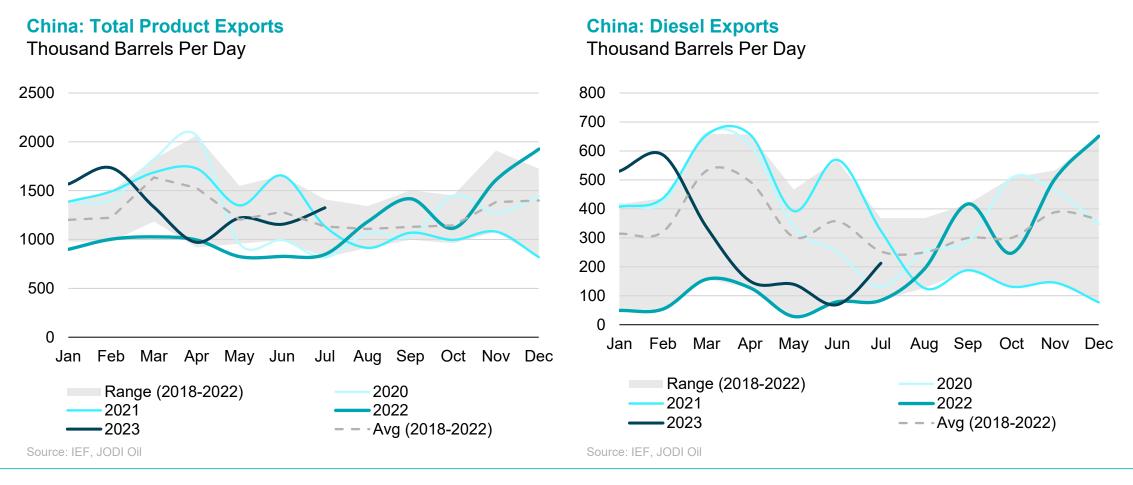


China's crude imports fell by 2.39 mb/d while demand fell by 2.71 mb/d



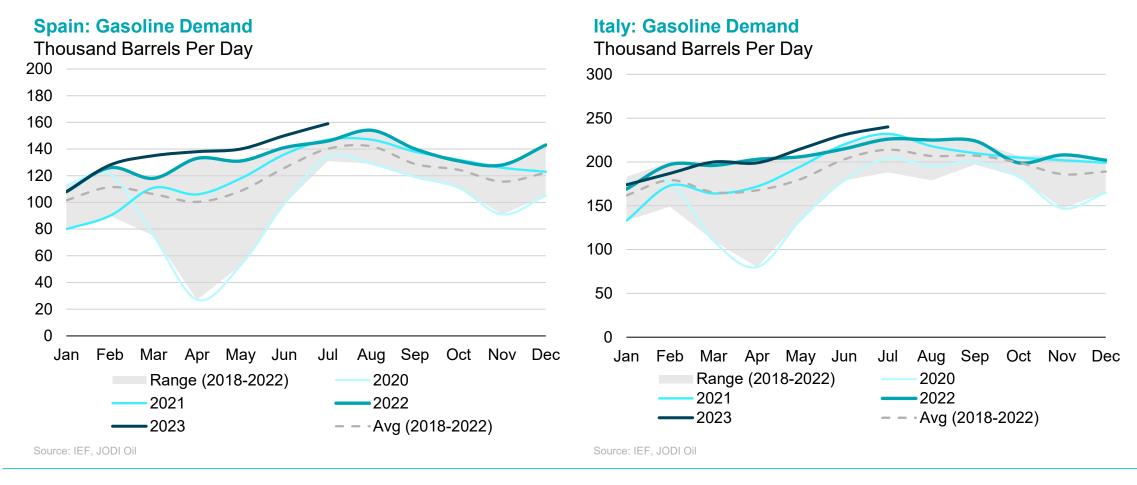


China's product exports rose by 169 kb/d driven higher diesel exports

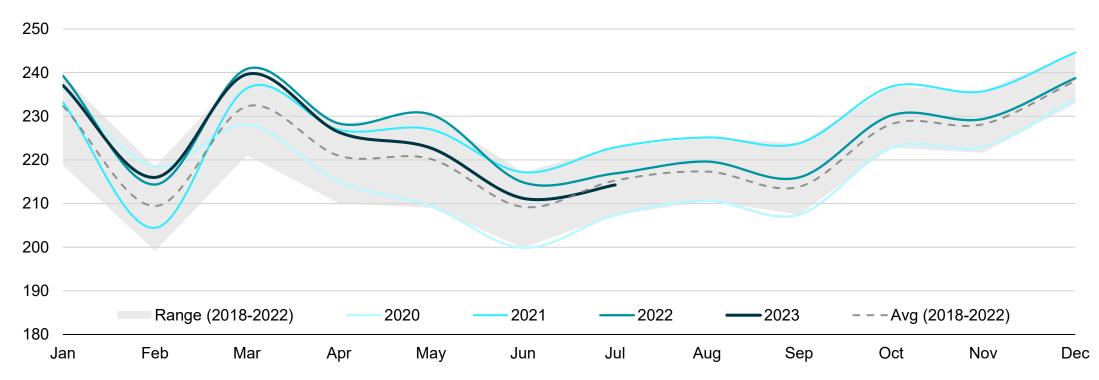

Billion Cubic Metres



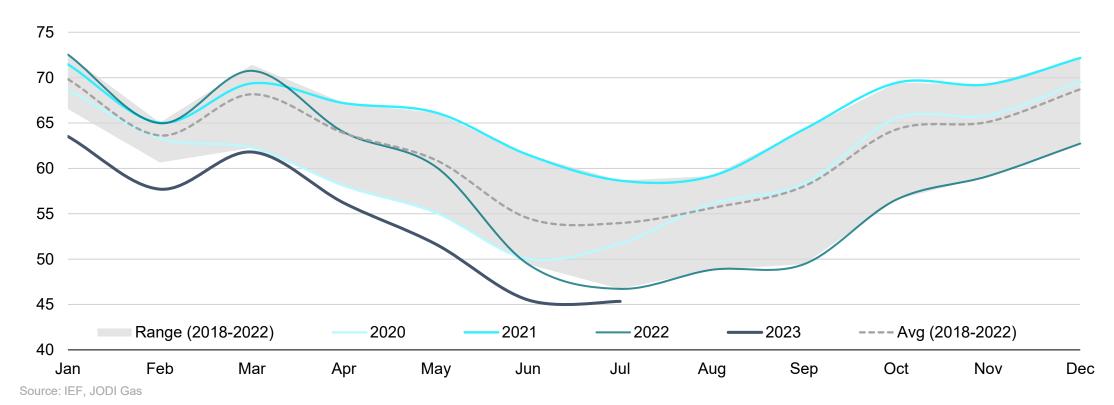

Billion Cubic Metres

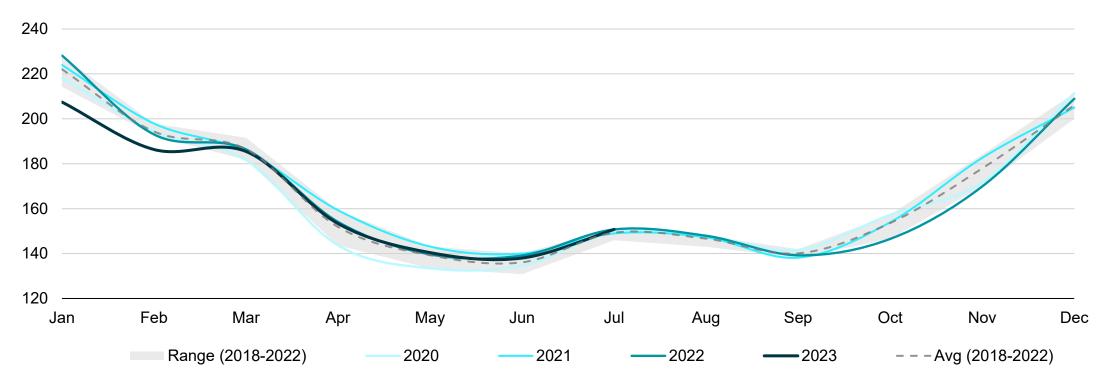




Natural gas demand rose seasonally in July and was near the top of the 5-year range

Billion Cubic Metres



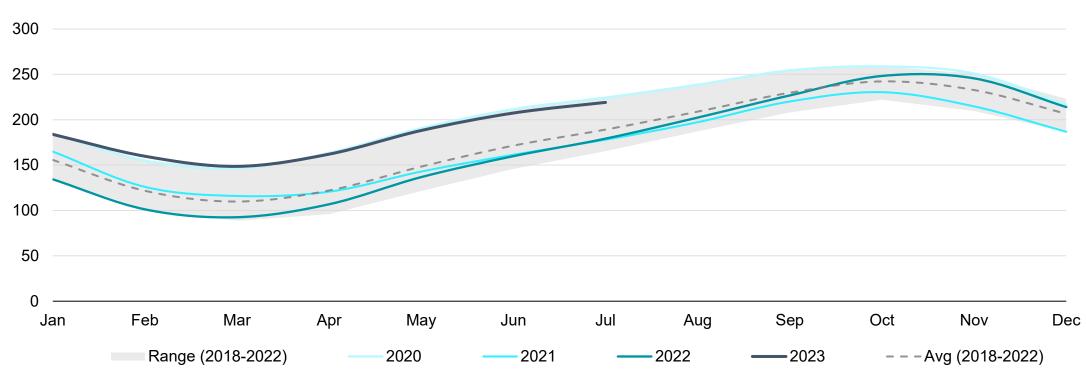

Natural Gas Closing Stocks (29 Countries)

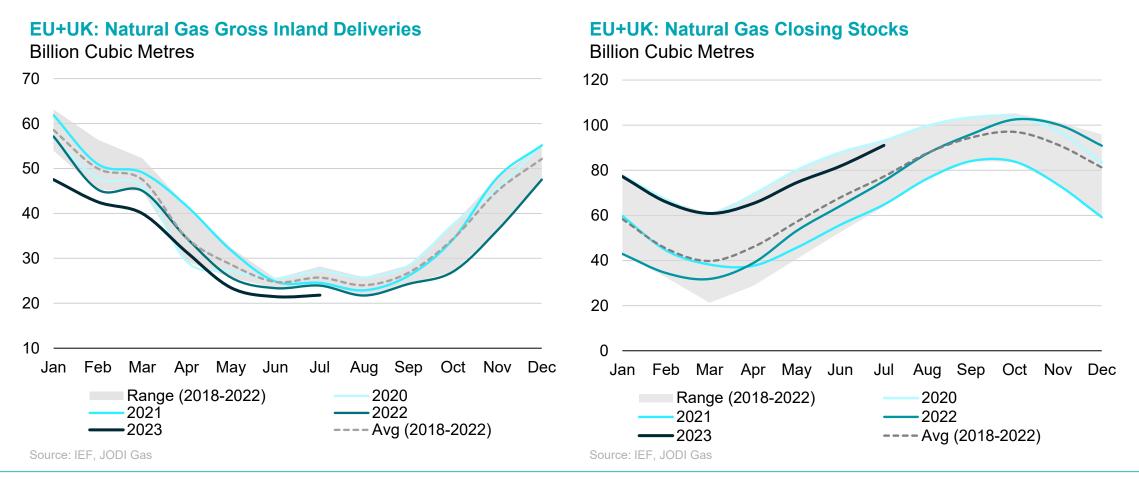
