### Oil Overview: Update with Data Through Oct 2023

- Oil demand in JODI-reporting countries was at a seasonal record high for a sixth consecutive month in October.
  - Demand was up 4 mb/d year-on-year driven by gains in China and the US.
  - China's crude imports rose by 402 kb/d m/m to 11.56 mb/d and were up 1.4 mb/d from year ago levels.
- Crude oil production slipped below the five-year average in October despite a slight month-on-month gain. Crude production was down 1.6 mb/d y/y led by a 2 mb/d y/y drop in Saudi Arabia.
  - Saudi Arabia's crude production fell by 35 kb/d in October to 8.9 mb/d while its crude exports rose by 543 kb/d to 6.30 mb/d. Saudi Arabia's refinery intake fell by 750 kb/d month-on-month.
- Crude and refined product inventories had a small net build in October, but they remained 285 mb below the five-year average.

### Gas Overview: Update with Data Through Oct 2023

- Natural gas production rose to an all-time high in October driven by gains in Australia, Norway, and China.
  - This month's update did not include gas data for Russia.
- Natural gas demand rose seasonally in October and was at the top of the 5-year seasonal range.
  - EU+UK natural gas demand rose seasonally but remained at the bottom of the 5-year seasonal range.
- Total gas inventories increased seasonally by 15.6 bcm month-on-month and were above the 5-year average.
  - EU+UK inventories rose by 5 bcm in October and stood nearly 99% full at the end of the month.

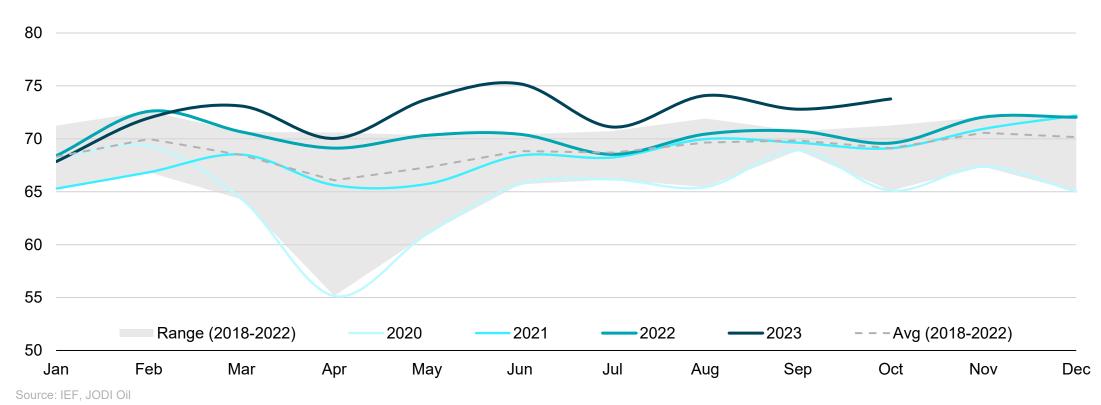

#### **Oil Product Demand (42 Countries)**

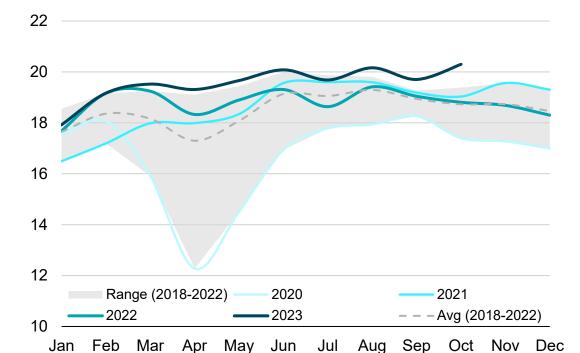

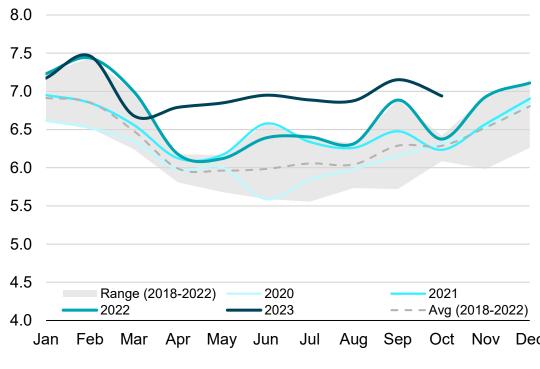
# Gasoline and LPG demand were at 5-year seasonal highs in October

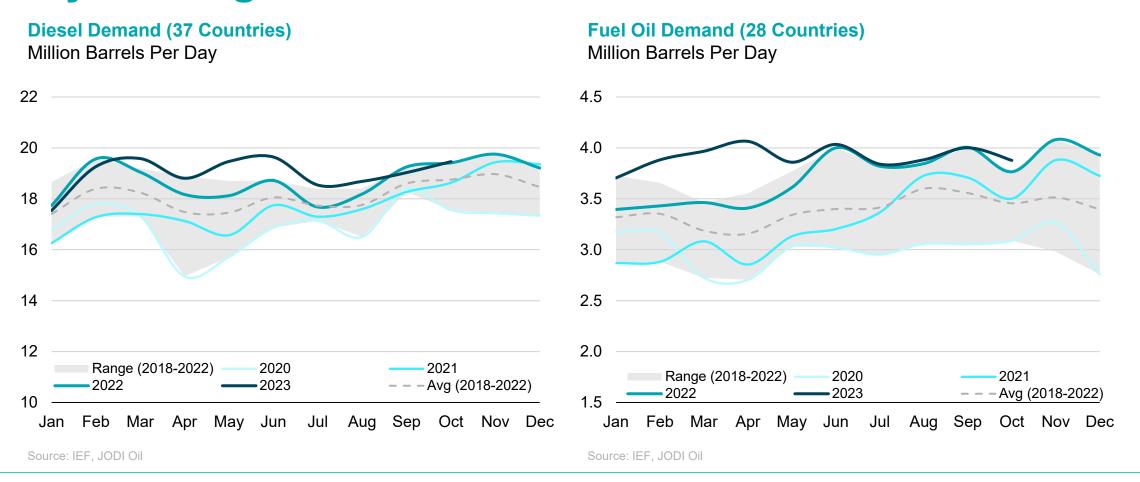

# Diesel demand was at the top of the 5-year range in October while fuel oil demand was slightly above the 5-year range

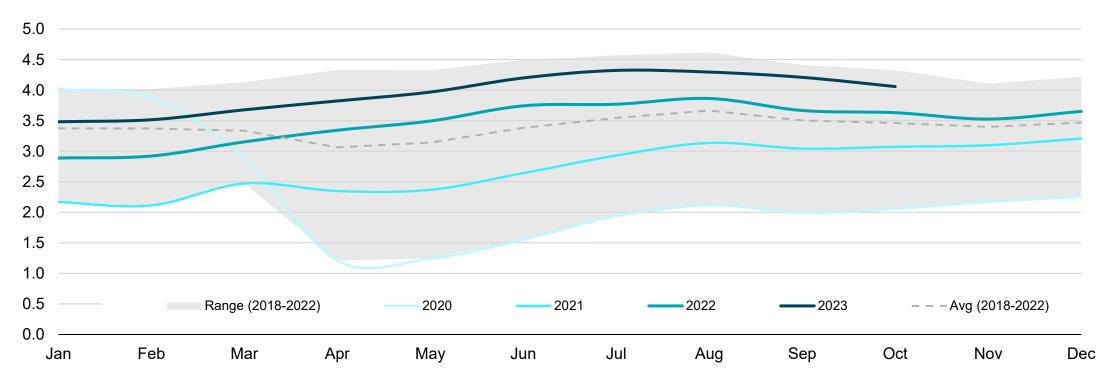




# Jet fuel demand fell marginally in October and was 5% below pre-COVID levels

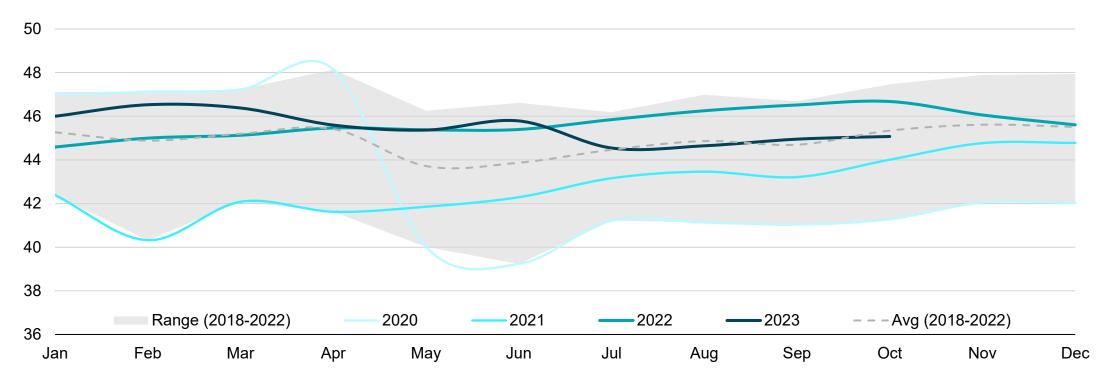


# Crude production slipped below the 5-year average despite a slight month-on-month gain

Million Barrels Per Day

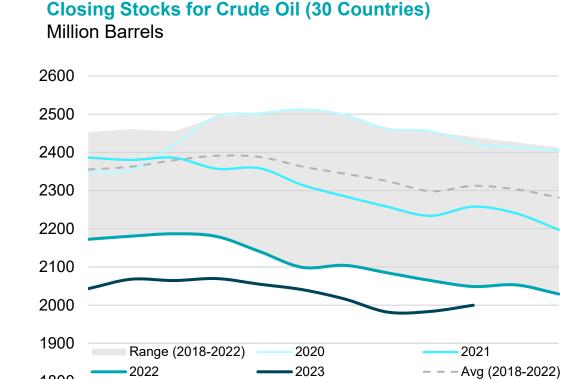

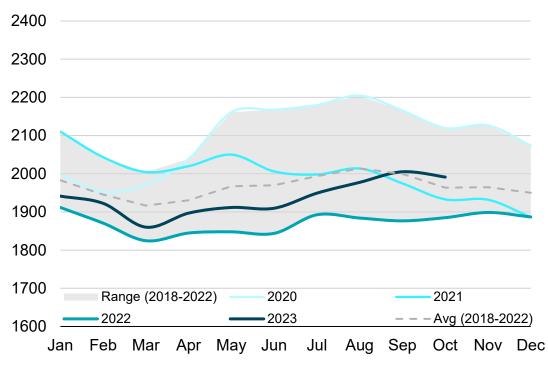
# Crude inventories rose by 16.2 mb in October while product inventories fell by 13.9 mb

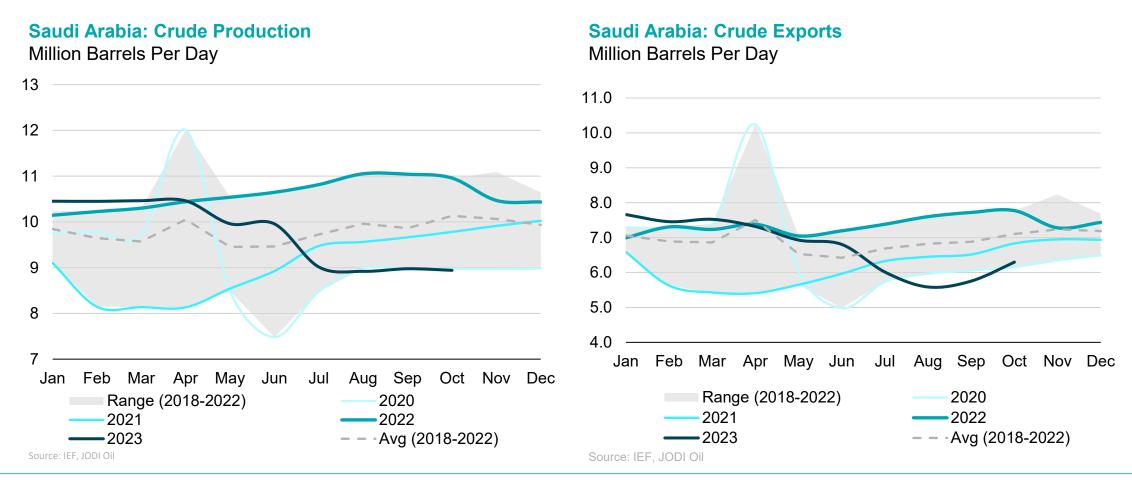

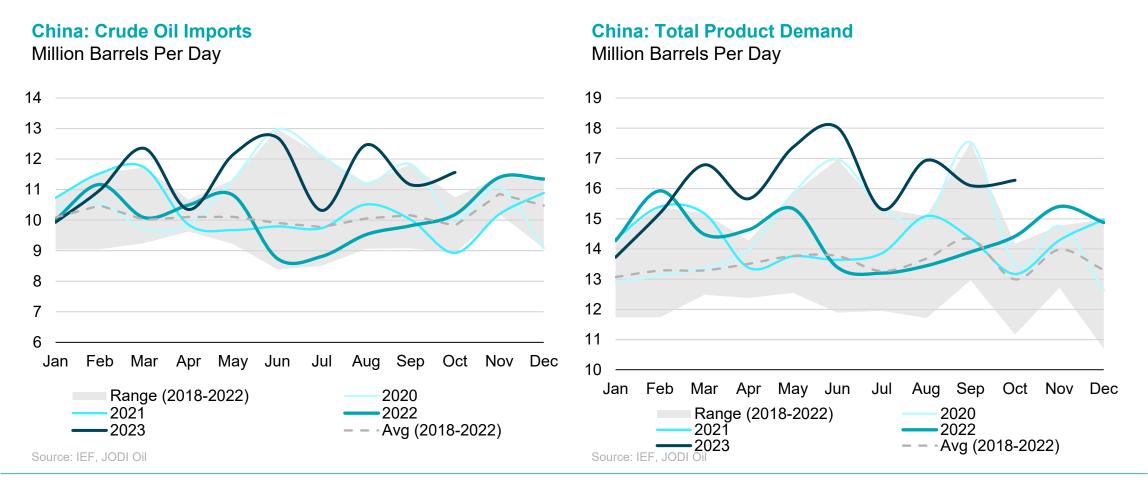


# Saudi crude production fell by 35 kb/d in October while exports rose by 543 kb/d to a 4-month high



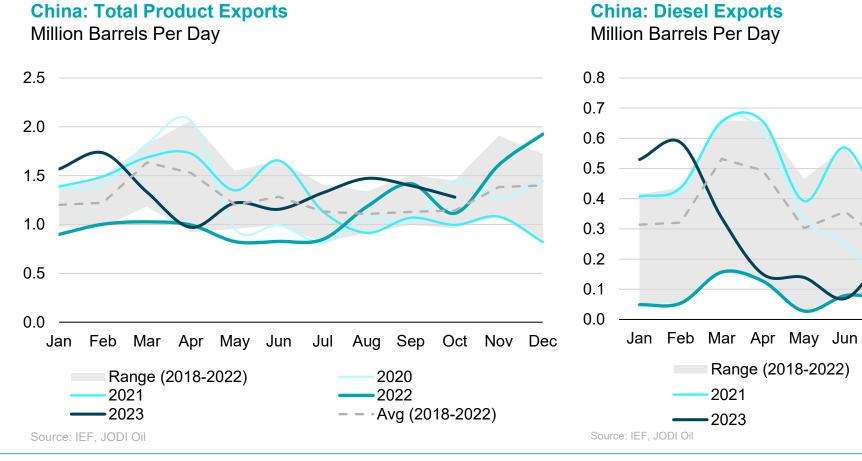


# China's crude imports rose by 402 kb/d in October while demand rose by 175 kb/d

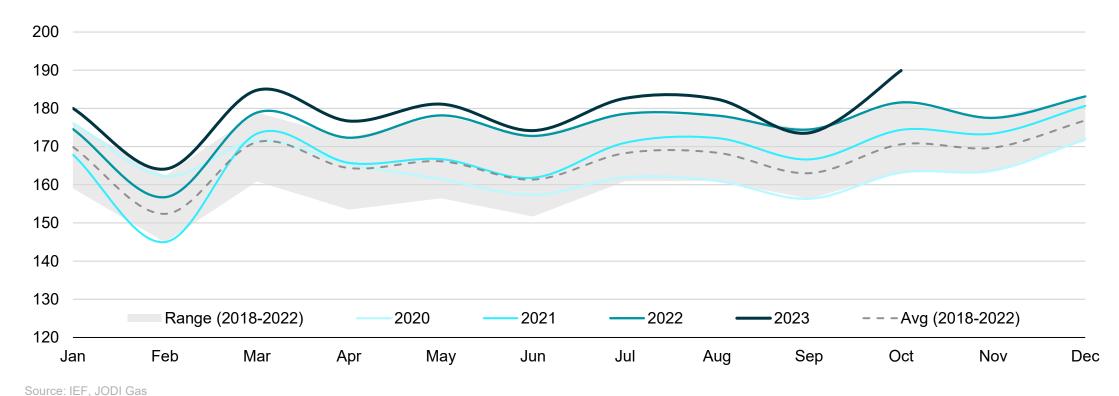

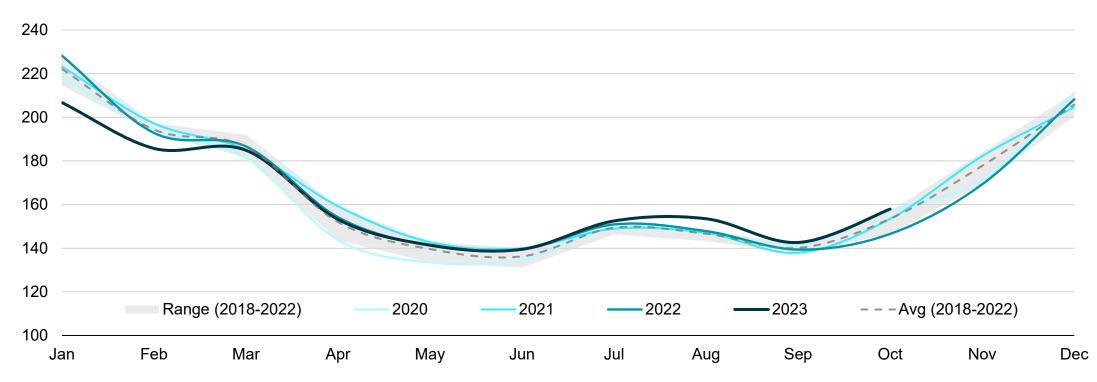




# Natural gas demand rose seasonally in October and was at the top of the 5-year range

**Billion Cubic Metres** 



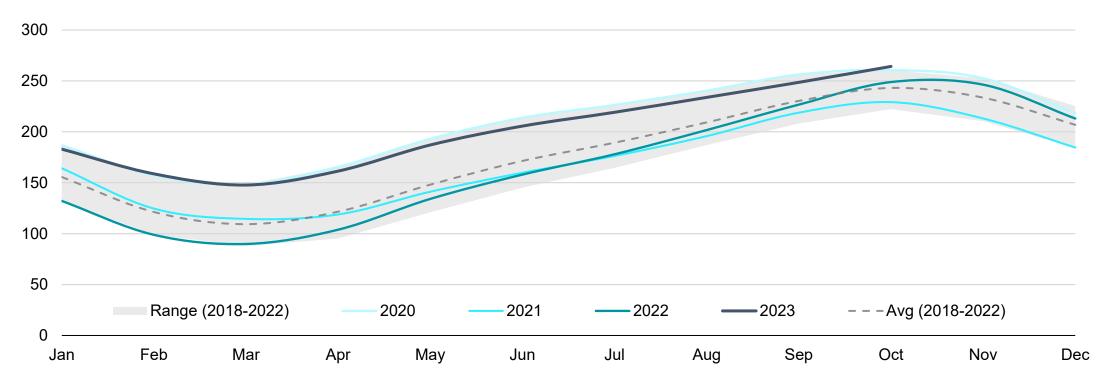

**Billion Cubic Metres** 

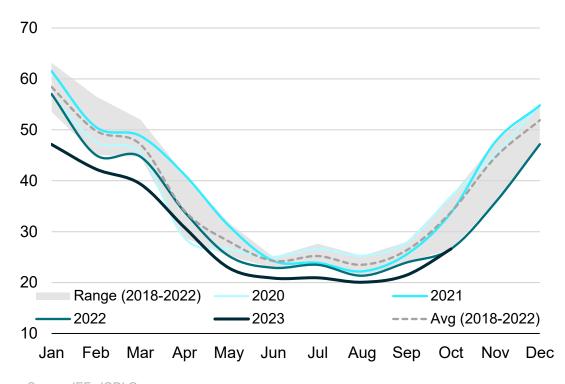

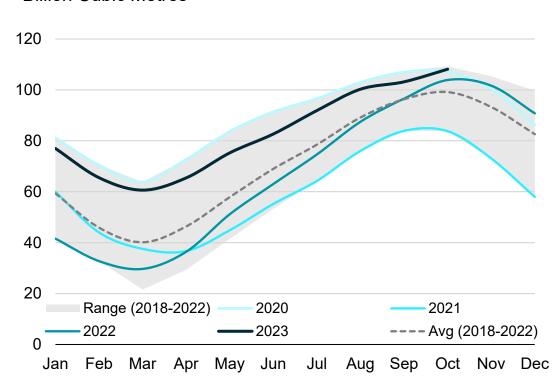


# EU+UK gas demand remained below the 5-year seasonal levels in October, helping inventories end the month at around 95% full
